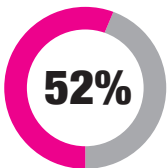

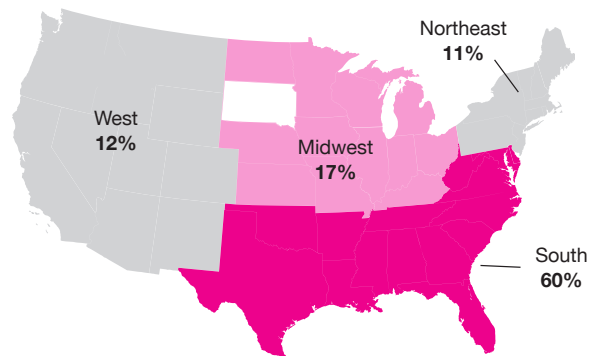

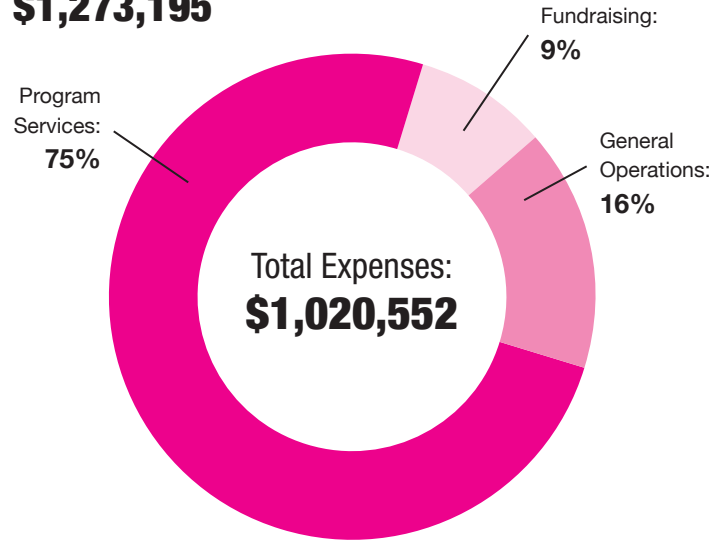

In Fiscal Year 2021, revenue to the organization fell by 31% and program expenses were reduced by more than \$750,000 with the elimination of in-person survivorship, education and awareness programming as a direct result of the pandemic.

In total, The DONNA CareLine has secured **\$4.2 million in financial services for 15,603 families** living with breast cancer from all walks of life, from every state, in both rural and urban communities.



FUNDING FOR RESEARCH

Since inception, The DONNA Foundation has disbursed **\$3.3 million to the Mayo Clinic Breast Cancer Translational Genomics Research program**. The DONNA Foundation funds novel research initiatives with the goal to more effectively diagnose, treat and ultimately finish breast cancer for all patients.
